- Consider Coleridge's "The Rime of the Ancient Mariner" as a myth of guilt and redemption.

- How is the tension between Hopkins' aesthetic and ascetic impulses resolved in "The Windhover"?
- Hopkins' 'terrible sonnets' represent a poetic articulation of desolation and abandonment and the progression from grief and despair to personal redemption. Discuss with reference to the poems recommended for you.
- Consider "Fra Lippo Lippi" as a successful example of dramatic monologue.
- Browning's dramatic monologues are soul-studies. Illustrate the view with reference to "Andrea del Sarto".
- Comment on Keats' positive approach to melancholy in "Ode on Melancholy".
- Discuss how Keats' "Ode to Psyche" is a poem on the working of poetic imagination.
